First-time request for a dependency status appeal: A signed, detailed letter from you, the student, explaining the extenuating circumstances, including your relationship with either your biological or adoptive parents. Please also include an explanation of where you expect to receive your financial support for the 2025-2026 academic year. A separate letter from an independent, third-party source (ex. judge, government official, case worker, clergy, medical authority, high school counselor) who can attest first-hand to your circumstances. This letter must include as much detail about the situation as possible. Request for renewal for previously approved dependency status appeal: A new, signed statement indicating your current relationship status with your biological or adoptive parents.
