

Verification of Non-Filing Letter Retrieval Instructions 2025-2026

As part of the verification process for financial aid, the U.S. Department of Education requires that students and parents who did not file taxes for 2023 submit a letter of non-filing status from the IRS. The Verification of Non-Filing Letter provides proof that the IRS has no record that a 1040 was filed by you for the year requested.

To Request a 2023 Verification of Non-filing Letter, free of charge:

> Mail

- Go to irs.gov
- Select Get Your Tax Record from the File dropdown menu
- Get Transcript by Mail
- Follow prompts to enter your Social Security Number, Date of Birth, Street Address and Zip
- Select Return Transcript as Transcript Type
- Select Tax Year of 2023

> Online (first-time users will need to create an ID.me account)

- Go to irs.gov
- Select Get Your Tax Record from the File dropdown menu
- Click Get Transcript Online
- You will have to request a code (it can be emailed or texted to you)
- Select Higher Education/Student Aid for the reason you need a transcript
- Under Return Transcript section, select 2023

> Telephone

- Call IRS at 1.800.908.9946
- Follow prompts to enter your Social Security Number and the numbers in your street address
- Select Option 2 to request the appropriate tax document and then enter 2023 for the tax year
- If successfully validated, you can expect to receive your documentation within 5-10 business days from the time of the request

Please make sure the student's first and last name and Lakeland ID number is written on each page before submitting the Verification of Non-filing Letter.
